

## CT Post-Primary Certification Training Program 2017 Information Sheet

### Program Details

- Up to 3 students selected
- 3 or 6 month certificate program beginning July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017
- Tuition - \$1,500 (\*tuition waiver available for eligible, full time NM employees)

### Program Duration

- 3 months full time (40 hours per week) or 6 months part time (20 hours per week)
  - July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017 – September 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017 for 3 month, full time program
  - July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017 – December 22<sup>rd</sup>, 2017 for 6 month, part time program
- Clinical rotation hours will vary
- **Mandatory** weekly didactic component on Tuesdays of each week
- 4 vacation days (in addition to regular holidays)

### Eligible Applicants

- Technologist (non-NM employee) possessing R.T. (R), (T), (N), or CNMT credentials seeking post-primary certification in CT
- NM employee in good standing, seeking post-primary certification in CT that possesses R.T. (R), (T), (N), or CNMT credentials (\*tuition waiver available for eligible, full time NM employees)
- Graduate of the NM Clinical Schools that has passed the board exam and possesses R.T. (R), (T), (N), or CNMT credentials

### How To Apply

All documents are due by the application deadline of **Friday, May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017**:

1. Submission of CT Program application and personal essay. Application is attached. Personal essay should be a one page description of your career goals and why you are interested in pursuing CT training.
2. Submission of two CT Training Program Recommendation Forms (form attached). Recommendation forms are to be emailed directly to the Registrar from the two references.
  - Recommendations should be from a department manager, lead technologist, clinical supervisor or coordinator, or a program director from current or most recent job/school.
3. Submission of official transcripts.
  - Applicants who attended a school other than the NM Clinical Schools: please request official transcripts to be sent directly from the institution to the Registrar;
  - Applicants who are graduates of the NM Clinical Schools: the Registrar will obtain and include a copy of your official transcript with your application packet.

**Application Deadline**

- Friday, May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2017

**Interview/Selection Process**

- Interviews - Thursday, June 1<sup>st</sup>
- Applicants notified of acceptance status by Monday, June 5<sup>th</sup>

**Program Completion**

- Complete all clinical rotation hours
- Complete ARRT requirements for procedural competencies
- Complete didactic component with an average grade of C or better
- Receive a grade of C or better on all rotation evaluations
- Meet with coordinator bi-weekly for review/case study/Q & A sessions
- Receive certificate upon completion of the program
